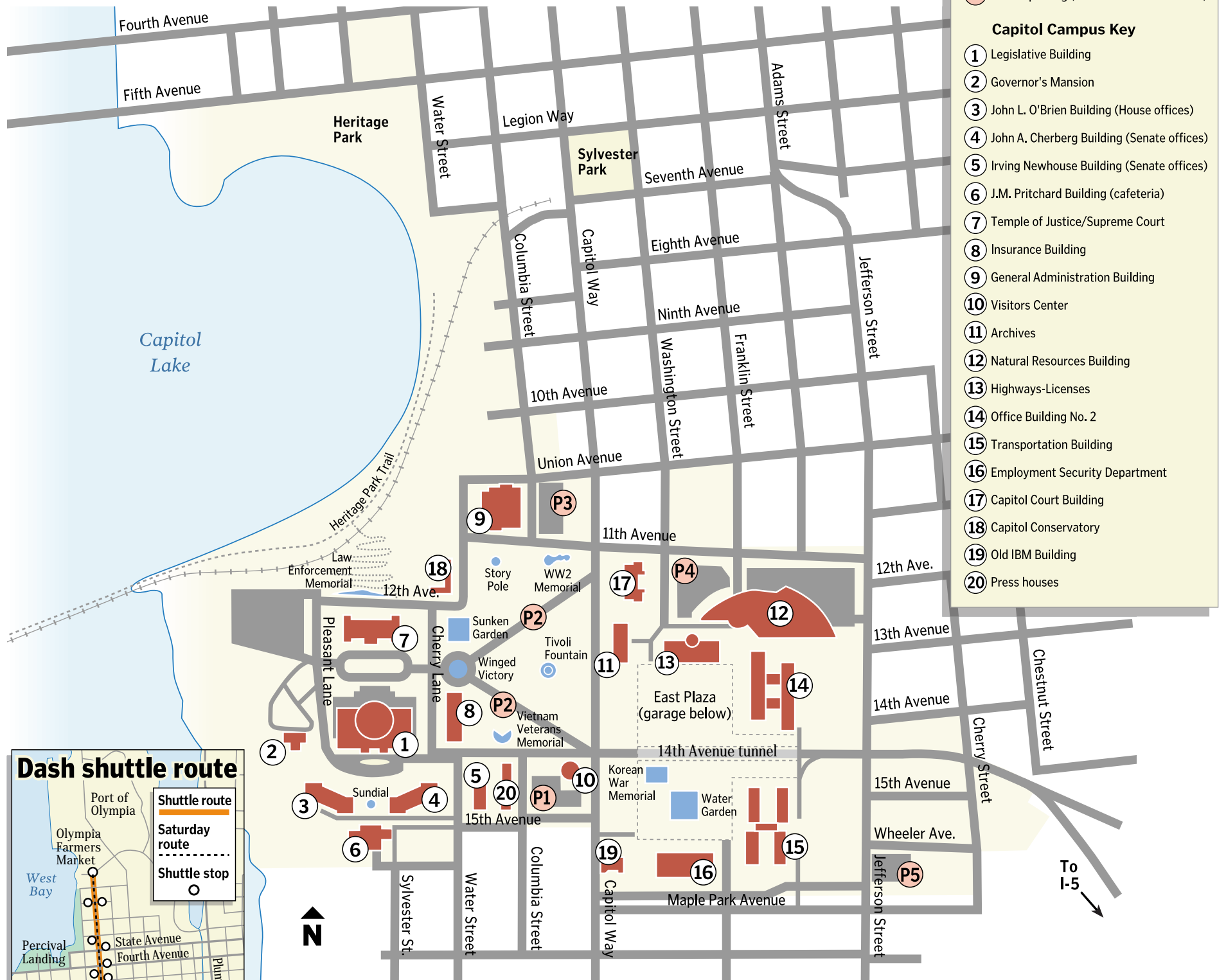

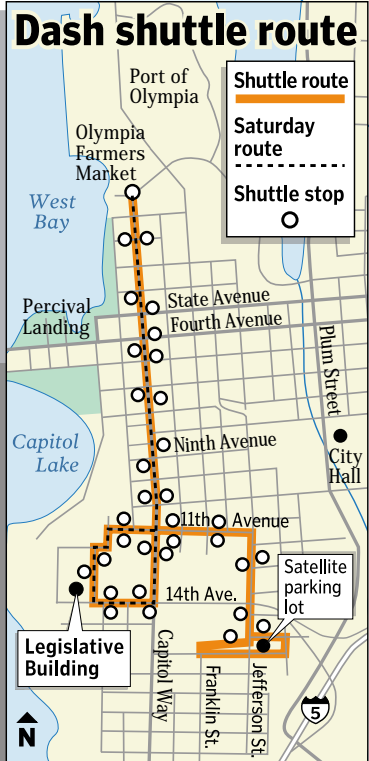

**Dash shuttle**  
 The Dash shuttle is free and runs between Capitol Campus and Olympia Farmers Market, also making a loop around the Wheeler Avenue satellite parking lot and making stops about every two blocks down Capitol Way. The service runs every 12 minutes from 6:45 a.m. until 7:15 p.m. weekdays. It also runs Saturdays, from April to December, every 10 minutes from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

**Parking Information**  
**P1. Visitor Information Center parking:** Located at the Visitor Information Center at 14th Avenue and Capitol Way. The phone number is 360-586-3460. Cost: 50 cents per hour.  
**P2. North and south diagonal parking:**

Located along the North and South diagonals on the Capitol Campus. Cost: 50 cents per hour.  
**P3. General Administration Parking Garage (upper level, cars and lighter vehicles only):** Located at 11th Avenue and Columbia Street. Cost: 50 cents per hour. Visitor parking for oversized vehicles is available on the west side of the GA building.  
**P4. Natural Resources Parking Lot:** Located off Washington Street. Parking is metered.  
**P5. Satellite/Wheeler Parking Lot:** Located at Jefferson Street and 16th Avenue (access off Jefferson). Parking is metered and accepts debit/credit cards.  
**Deschutes Parkway along Capitol Lake:** Intercity Transit buses run to the Olympia transit center for transfer to Capitol Campus and other destinations weekdays every half hour. The fare is

75 cents for a single ride or \$1.50 for an all-day pass.  
**Tour and school buses:** Buses may unload and reload passengers on Capitol Campus at the Winged Victory monument (at the junction of the North and South diagonals). Buses should then park in the bus parking area at the Satellite Visitor Parking Lot.
